ACREAGE: Approximately 73.6 acres with merchantable timber

BASIS FOR SAWTIMBER VOLUME ESTIMATES: Sawtimber volume estimates are based on a systematic timber inventory using 35 variable plot sampling points on 73.6 acres. Sawtimber trees were measured down to a 10" or merchantable top. All volumes are expressed in International ¼" Log Rule.

DESCRIPTION: The Brenneman forest is a hardwood forest with about 3.6 acres of mature, planted white pine. Sawtimber volumes average approximately 12,083 board feet per acre, International ¼" Log Rule. Overall, the sawtimber trees average approximately 225 board feet per tree. Grade and quality of the trees is very good. Logging conditions are challenging in some places due to steep slopes and rocky soils, but all acreage is considered operable for a commercial timber harvest operation.
